Sir/Madam,


It is brought to the notice of the Board that the extremely severe cyclone "Michaung" is expected to cross North Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh region by Monday or Tuesday. It is observed that thousands of life of animals and human beings are facing a threat of losing their lives and unpredictable destruction of property. Thus, the cyclone Michaung is going to inflict very heavy damage on vast tracts of land, road/transport facilities/electricity etc., especially in the cities near the seashore of Tamil Nadu and Gujarat.

2. It is therefore, understood that there is an urgent need to help the suffering and affected animals in the areas affected by cyclone, by providing medicines, food, shelter and water to the animals. Hence, it is requested to provide emergency relief to the distressed animals.

3. The Board also requests the AWOs/SPCAs to volunteer to do relief work and provide emergency relief to the distressed animals. With your support we hope to provide assistance to the distressed animals in this hour of crisis.
